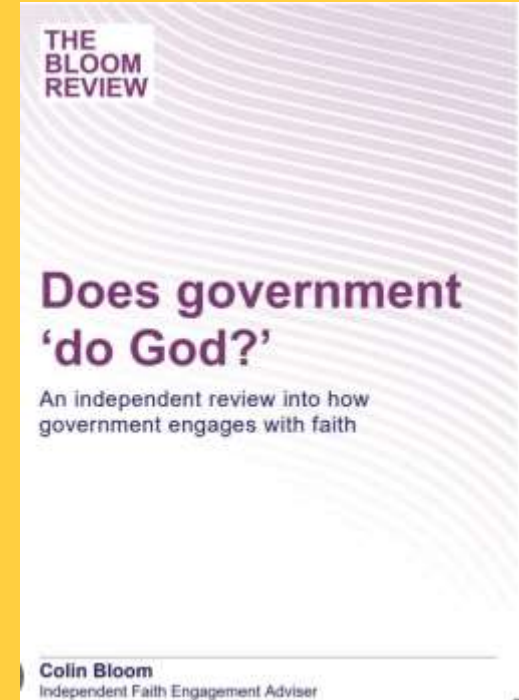



78% say
