Young Ambassador questions to the Children's Commissioner:

- How can RE help us to be seen in school?
- How can we make our Pupil Voice heard more loudly?
- How can Dame Rachel help us raise the profile of RE in our school?
- How can RE help us understand fake from real?
- What makes a good RE teacher?
 - A subject specialist who champions RE.
- Is RE a more important subject now than ever before?
 - Yes! for better understanding yourself and for your future life.
- Why does RE deserve a place in our school curriculum?
 - Because it promotes understanding between and within communities.
 - It stimulates good conversations & promotes critical thinking.
- How can we help to change our parents' ideas about RE being the same as when they were at school?
 - Ask Y7 what they remember about their Primary RE lessons, then ask their parents what RE was like for them? Open up discussion in class what do you think RE **should** be like?
 - ❖ Invite parents to a vibrant RE project / Saturday community event at a local place of religious interest.

Linked questions for SACRE

- Dame Rachel says children are hopeful, positive and hugely ambitious, and they need agency how does your SACRE incorporate Pupil Voice and listen to the needs of children in your area?
 - Invite pupils to syllabus discussions
 - Annual RE celebration events
 - Pupil Voice Conference
 - School visits with LA Adviser to meet with children and gather PV
 - Recording PV to play at SACRE meetings
 - ❖ SACRE member attends local Youth Parliament
 - ❖ Workshops in schools pupils give feedback / comments fed into SACRE meetings
 - SACRE members and others engage with schools as 'Living Faiths'.
- How can good RE tackle challenging issues?

By asking good Qs, led by good, well-qualified teachers who can create a safe space.

- Why is RE so patchy in different schools?
 - It depends on the teachers no/few trained RE specialists, little opportunity for CPD
 - Governors may not support RE therefore do not put pressure on HTs to ensure it's properly resourced
 - ❖ Poor finance / poor understanding of importance of RE in the curriculum.
- How does SACRE support RE in using ethical & philosophical questions to build pupils' understanding of faith & belief?
 - ❖ By using the enquiry approach throughout the Agreed Syllabus, from EYFS onwards.
- How can we ensure that Primary children know about other religions and not just Christianity?
 - Encourage all schools to use the Agreed Syllabus, and support them to facilitate high quality RE.
