


Why subscribe to NASACRE?

Your SACRE exists to fulfil the law, which states that RE must be taught in all schools and it is a SACRE's responsibility to advise the local authority on what needs to be done to improve Religious Education (RE) and Collective Worship (CW) for local schools. Through a SACRE, local communities and teachers can influence directly what pupils learn about religious and non-religious worldviews.

SACREs need support; this is where NASACRE can help. The NASACRE Executive Committee has close links with national partners, for example the Association of RE Inspectors, Advisers and Consultants (AREIAC) and the National Association of Teachers of RE (NATRE) – as well as having an active voice at meetings with the DfE, the RE Council of England and Wales (REC) and the Inter-Faith Network UK (IFN).

NASACRE exists to help you promote and sustain RE, interfaith understanding and sensitivity, professional development and to campaign for adequate and satisfactory resourcing to achieve these aims. The Exec Committee works to a 3-year development plan, so we remain current and focused.

While All SACREs in England are affiliated to NASACRE, and many sections of our website may be publicly accessed by everyone, some content is available only to those SACREs that subscribe. Every subscription supports NASACRE to better fulfil its aims.
